

**The Following Protocols Have Been Put in Place
by the
Episcopal Diocese of Long Island
and MUST Be Followed At ALL Times**

Masks Must Be Worn

Anyone over the age of 2 years old MUST wear a MASK when they are in ANY of the buildings—EVEN IF YOU ARE BY YOURSELF!

Use Hand Sanitizer

Upon entering the building, you must sanitize your hands. There are numerous stations that have been set up.

Using the Restrooms

ONLY ONE MALE and ONE FEMALE will be permitted in the restrooms at any given time. In addition to washing your hands, you will be expected to use Hand Sanitizer.

No Food or Drink Permitted

NO EATING OR DRINKING will be allowed at all. This includes any food, whether it is purchased or brought from home.

There are NO EXCEPTIONS!

Social Distancing

When one or more people are in the building at the same time, Social Distancing Rules of at least 6 feet apart will apply, regardless of the building you are in.

Gatherings

Church Members: No Coffee Hour is permitted whether or not food/drinks are served.

Outside Groups: Groups of more than 10 people are NOT permitted and all social distancing rules apply.

Ventilation

No Fans or air conditioners may be used. Windows may be opened, and should be opened for more ventilation.
